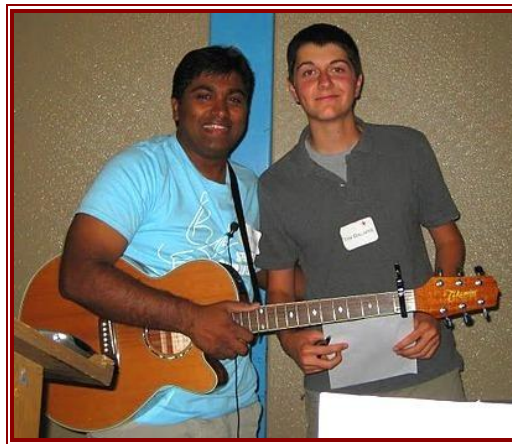
- Secluded areas for quiet time with the Lord

Paul realized it was a good thing for him to draw near to Christ. However, he also realized that when one drew near to Christ it also meant one must draw near to His cross. Paul declared, "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me." (Gal. 2:20). Paul knew he must trust in the Lord and allow the dying of the Lord Jesus to work deeply within his soul – only then could the life of Jesus be truly manifested to a dying world in all its glory – only then would Paul be able to declare His works to all of mankind. Christ was real to Paul! How real is He to us? How would you answer the question, "How real is Christ to me?" Join us as we meditate upon this.
